- 5. Each contestant shall submit a completed application either typed or handwritten. Applications may be obtained from the cooperative's office, online www.npec.org/youth-tour or your high school principal or counselor's office.

- 7. Applicants must be able to attend the interview process scheduled for **Wednesday**, **December 4**, **2024**, **at 6:00 p.m.**

Judges will ask you questions about yourself such as your personal abilities, school activities, goals, and accomplishments. They will also ask you what you have learned about the cooperatives.
